ACTIVE	APE	Adv Practice Experiential PM	Experiential-learning course during the 4th year of the PharmD program.	Adv. Placement Experiential-PHRM	
ACTIVE	ENS	Ensemble	Course with 10 or more participants performing music. Examples are orchestras, bands and choruses. Size is determined by the medium and requirements of the musical score. Taken for credit or zero credit hours.	Ensemble-SA	
ACTIVE	IND	Independent Study	Intensive individualized study under the direction of a qualified faculty member. Follows a negotiated plan of study culminating in a comprehensive written report and/or examination and/or artistic project. Class usually has 1-10 students. Is not for completion of a thesis or dissertation or for meeting the research requirement for a degree. Examples include Directed Studies and Special Projects.		
ACTIVE	INT	Internship	Experiential learning course where students perform disciplinary related, non-paid work off campus such as field work/experience, student teaching and cooperative education. Students follow a negotiated and/or directed plan of study.		
ACTIVE	LAB	Laboratory	Course meets in a defined physical setting (i.e., laboratory) for the purpose of the application of methods and principles of a discipline. Section size varies according to accreditation standards, pedagogical limitations, level of offering, availability of laboratory stations, and equipment.	Laboratory (only)	
ACTIVE	LEC	Lecture	Course in which faculty members give oral presentations of facts, principles, context, or interpretation. Instruction takes place in a traditional classroom setting. Section size varies widely.	Lecture (only)	
ACTIVE	LLB	Lecture/Lab combination	Combined lecture and lab. Lab portion not assigned credit hours or registered separately.		
ACTIVE	PER	Performance	Course with a formal exhibition or presentation before an audience, as a play, musical program, etc.	Performance-SA	
ACTIVE	PRL	Private Lesson	Course of instruction, usually in music, limited to 1 student.	Private Lesson-SA	
ACTIVE	RES	Research	No extra info available.		
ACTIVE	SEM	Seminar	Highly focused, topical course usually at an upper or graduate level. Format includes student presentations and discussions of reports based on literature, practices, problems or research. May be conducted over electronic media such as Internet. Generally limited to less than 20 students.

ACTIVE	STU	Studio	Course involves the demonstration and application of design and theory in a defined physical setting (i.e., studio). Students explore and experiment under the guidance of an instructor with significant one-on-one student/instructor interaction. Enrollment is typically less than 10 students. Includes music ensembles with less than 10 performers such as trios, quartets and quintets.		
ACTIVE	WEB	Web-based Learning (>50%)	Course with at least 50% of scheduled meetings and testing on-line that is supplemented by materials placed on the web.		
RETIRED	ACT	Physical Activity	Course requires performance of a physical activity. Proper technique of the activity is presented. Generally 10-35 students in a class.	No longer active on UCC form	Consider using LEC instead
RETIRED	CLK	Clerkship	Required course of clinical studies in the latter part of an undergraduate professional curriculum.	No longer active on UCC form	Consider using LAB instead
RETIRED	CLN	Clinical Laboratory	Course in a clinical laboratory setting including practice labs, hospitals, or other agencies. Students apply methods and principles of a clinical discipline. Enrollments are typically fewer than 10. Faculty members maintain close supervision of the students.	No longer active on UCC form	Consider using LAB instead
RETIRED	CLP	Critical Language Program	Lecture-based class with significant use of the Language Center for technology-based content and drill work.	No longer active on UCC form	Consider using LEC instead
RETIRED	CPL	Computer Lab Instruction	Course with instruction focused on technology or the application of technology to the field. Could be in a computer lab or in other setting.	No longer active on UCC form	Consider using LAB instead

RETIRED	DIS	Dissertation	Preparation of doctoral dissertation. A formal treatise presenting the results of study submitted in partial fulfillment of the requirements for a doctoral degree. The process requires extensive and intensive one-on-one interaction between the candidate and professor with more limited interaction between and among the candidate and the other members of the committee.
